To whom it may concern:

Low levels of benzene, polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons, metals, Perfluorooctanoic Acid (PFOA) and Perfluorooctanesulfonic Acid (PFOS) were discovered in ground water near the middle part of the above-referenced property at concentrations that slightly exceed New Jersey's Ground Water Quality Standards. The contamination is suspected to have occurred over the many decades of operations, and may be naturally occurring or may be attributable to background conditions. Since ground water is contaminated, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection requires that a determination be made as to the presence of any potentially potable wells at properties within 250 feet to 500 feet of the contaminated ground water. Property that you own is located within this distance.

I am writing to you to determine if there are any domestic wells (also known as potable wells or drinking water wells) or irrigation wells on your property. Please contact me at 732-469-8888 ext. 216 or via email at jnovelli@askesa.com and advise of your property address or Block and Lot, and any details that you may have about your well(s) including well depth, diameter, exact location, etc. You may use the enclosed form if it is helpful to you.

If no such wells are present, that is also helpful information and a response would be appreciated. If a well is present on your property, we would like to visit your property to determine if testing the well water would be required. Such testing of the well would be at no cost to you.
